- High-quality insect nets for field, pond, or stream use
- Binoculars (8x40 or similar)
- Spotting scope
- Teenager-sized outdoor clothing for camping trips, such as fleece jackets, wool hats, windpants, rain gear, ponchos, or windbreakers. Please call for specifics.
- Magnifying containers for insects
- Field guides for adults or children
- Compasses for student use – basic is fine
- An increment borer for taking tree cores
- Children's books, preferably outdoors or nature related
- A big blanket for kids to sit on outside
- Basic, inexpensive, handheld GPS units for use with students
- Kayaking equipment, such as drybags (10L or 20L), paddle jackets, flares (unexpired), or waterproof 2-way radios.
- Camping equipment, such as sleeping bags, air mattresses, bowls, plates, cups, etc. Please call for details & guidance – everything needs to fit into a sea kayak!
- A small to mid-sized daypack for counselors to use carrying supplies
- Clean joint compound pails for collecting sea critters (we just need a few)
